## School Year 2013-2014

In School Year 2013-14 Loudoun County Public Schools served more than 70,858 students, approximately 19,000 students were eligible to receive Free and Reduced (F/R) Meals. There were only 12,960 students who actually received F/R Meals. Of those students, only 1,983 of the students received food through the Backpack Coalition Program.

LCPS Office of Outreach conducted a pilot program during April through June 2014 and provided family-style meals for more than 133 students in 4 schools who were on a waiting list for their schools' Backpack Coalition program.

## School Year 2014-2015

LCPS's enrollment is expected to continue increasing annually by nearly 2% with an enrollment of more than 73,458 students in the beginning of School Year 2014-15. To date, there are 12,301 students receiving F/R Meals. Of those students, there are 2,561 students enrolled in the Backpack Coalition Program (up 23% from last school year). There are 25 Loudoun County organizations/business supporting 50 schools/2,036 students.

Currently, the LCPS Backpack Coalition Program is filling the gap for 22 schools for a total of 525 students (up 77% from last school year's pilot program); ensuring children have food for the weekend.

## LCPS Backpack Coalition Program

Backpack Coalition Program is a District-approved supplemental program to an existing school's Backpack Coalition Program. We coordinate with Loudoun Interfaith Relief and Blue Ridge Area Food Bank and developed a process to purchase food for food-insecure family's currently needing support.

The LCPS Backpack Coalition Program is collaborating with 100WomenStrong, Blue Ridge Area Food Bank, Loudoun County Interfaith Relief, Loudoun Education Foundation, Corporations, small businesses and Loudoun County citizens to ensure no child goes hungry.

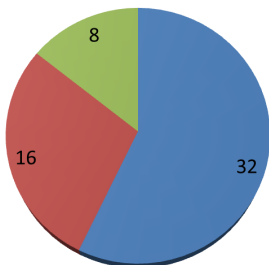
## LCPS Backpack Coalition

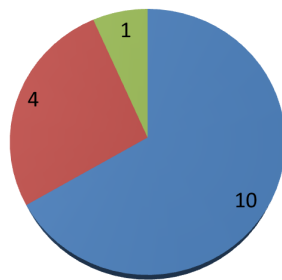
### Hunger Doesn't Take Weekends Off

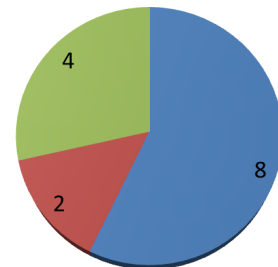
**Elementary School**
